

Construction Notice

Refurbishment to begin on transmission lines between the Town of Iroquois Falls and the Town of Kirkland Lake

In order to ensure the continued safe and reliable supply of electricity, Hydro One Networks Inc. (Hydro One) is refurbishing approximately 90 km of the existing 115 kilovolt transmission line between Ansonville Transformer Station (TS), located near the Town of Iroquois Falls and Kirkland Lake TS located in the Town of Kirkland Lake. Hydro One has contracted the construction work to Forbes Bros. and crews will begin construction activities in January 2022. As part of this project, work includes replacing the conductor (wire) along the existing right-of-way, replacing and repairing wood pole structures and maintenance activities for some lattice steel structure foundations.


Work will be completed along the corridor using heavy equipment, including excavators, dump trucks, bucket trucks and helicopters, and will take place Monday to Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

The project is expected to be completed mid-2023 and there are no outages for local residents expected as a part of this work. We understand that construction can be disruptive and we thank you for your patience as we complete this important refurbishment project.
