## Join us to learn more about Hydro One's Conductor Replacement Project in your community

This fall Hydro One will begin construction activities to replace and refurbish overhead lines and equipment along the existing corridor between our Hawthorne Transmission Station (TS) and Merivale TS located in Gloucester (see reverse map). These circuits are a vital connection point for Hydro One and Ottawa Hydro and supply electricity to the Ottawa region.

Community members are invited to come out and learn more about the project and what can be expected as our crews complete this important work.

### Project Description

The project will involve the replacement of the existing conductor (wire), reinforcement of the existing transmission structures where necessary and the installation of a temporary bypass on the corridor beside Albion TS to facilitate the construction process. A Class Environmental Assessment for Minor Transmission Facilities was completed for this project in July 2020. Work will be carried out within the existing transmission corridor and, where possible, access to the transmission structures will be gained using existing roads, transmission corridor and trails.

There will be times when construction activities will take place outside of normal working hours to accommodate scheduled outages on the transmission circuits. No residential power interruptions are expected as a part of this project and work is anticipated to be complete by December 2023.

We understand that construction can be disruptive and we thank you for your patience.

### COVID-19 protocols during Community Information Centre

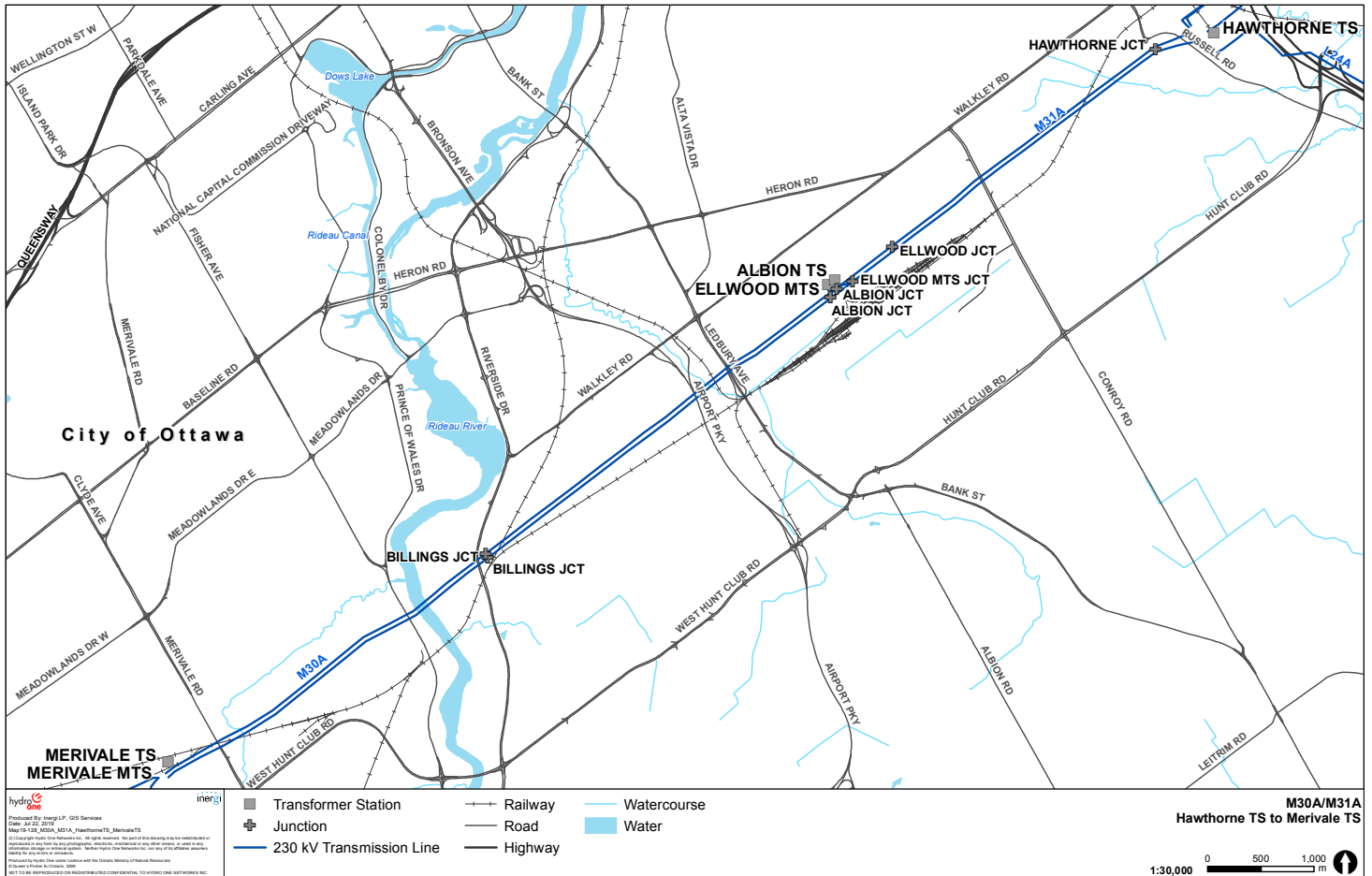
