



## LDC FIT CIA Application Process

The OPA has awarded Feed in Tariff (FIT) contracts to a number of Capacity Allocation Exempt (CAE) projects and we would like to remind you that a Connection Impact Assessment (CIA) is required from Hydro One for any generation projects **greater than 10 kW** connecting in your LDC downstream of a Hydro One owned Transformer Station.

The BCC will process your CIA application and monitor the status to ensure a timely response. In anticipation of a large volume of CIA requests from LDCs, Hydro One is proposing an option to receive a Threshold CIA under certain conditions. The Threshold CIA would enable connection of a number of CAE inverter based generation projects up to 250 kW in size on LDC owned feeders up to a pre-determined capacity level. Further details of this option will be forthcoming in a bulletin.
