Hydro One Notice of Capacity Expiring for Distributed Generation Projects

As you may be aware, the Distribution System Code requires that we remove the capacity allocated to distributed generation projects if a Connection Cost Agreement (CCA) and associated deposits are not completed within 12 months for those projects that had a Connection Impact Assessment (CIA) issued prior to October 21, 2009.

This notice is to let you know that our Business Customer Centre will be sending you a list of the projects located within your distribution service territory that had CIAs issued more than 12 months ago but have not yet executed a CCA. If a CCA and associated deposits are not received within 60 days of receiving the list, Hydro One must remove the capacity allocated to the projects.
