Posting Available Capacity for Distribution Generation Connections

On September 21, 2009, the Ontario Energy Board made several amendments to the Distribution System Code. In Section 6.2.4.1, amendments were made to address Distribution Connected Generation and the requirement for Distributors to establish and maintain their Capacity Allocation process.

To comply with amended code requirements for generator applications, Hydro One will update our website on or before March 1st, 2010 as follows:

- The current "List of Applications" for each Transformer Station (TS) will be replaced with a "List of Allocated Capacity" (LAC) by TS.
- The LAC will track the total Allocated Capacity on each of the Hydro One owned feeders at the TS, based on completed CIA's for Projects connecting to each feeder. Posted information will also include any allocated capacity for Hydro One owned feeders embedded in a LDC system.
- The LAC indicator for feeders owned entirely by a LDC and connected to a Hydro One TS will refer the viewer to the LDC locator tool on the OPA website. It is Hydro One's expectation your LDC will post the Allocated Capacity for those feeders in your own venue.
