Class Environmental Study Report

Toronto Lakeshore Infrastructure Renewal Project

Hydro One Networks Inc. (Hydro One) has completed the Class Environmental Assessment (EA) for the proposed Toronto Lakeshore Infrastructure Renewal Project. This project involves replacing parts of the aging high-voltage electricity infrastructure that serves the western and downtown areas of Toronto. In order to ensure that Toronto Hydro customers continue to receive an adequate and reliable supply of electricity, Hydro One proposes to replace two existing 115 kilovolt underground transmission circuits connecting Strachan Transformer Station and Riverside Junction.

Hydro One is proposing to replace the circuits using the existing route, with one diversion between Parkside Drive and Roncesvalles Avenue (see map), where circuits would be relocated to the southern westbound lane of Lake Shore Boulevard West. These underground circuits were installed in the late 1950s and are nearing the end of their service life. This circuit replacement was identified as part of Hydro One's regular asset sustainment program. Hydro One is targeting to have the proposed work completed by December 2013.

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR INPUT

In accordance with the *Class EA for Minor Transmission Facilities*, the draft Environmental Study Report (ESR) will be available for public review and comment for a 45-day period from March 7, 2011 to April 20, 2011. 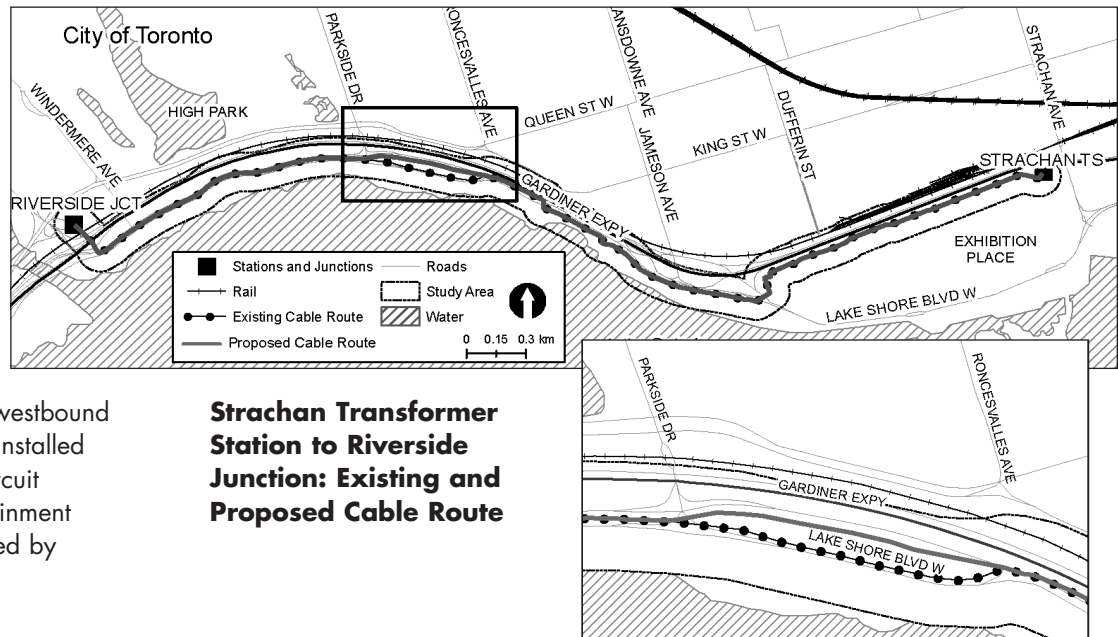

Hydro One will respond to and make best efforts to resolve any issues raised by concerned parties during the public review period. If no concerns are expressed, the ESR will be finalized and filed with the Ministry of the Environment (MOE). The project will be considered acceptable and will proceed as outlined in the draft ESR.

The *Environmental Assessment Act* has provisions that allow interested parties to ask for a higher level of assessment for a Class EA project if they feel that outstanding issues have not been adequately addressed by Hydro One. This higher level of assessment is referred to as a Part II Order request. Such requests must be addressed in writing to the Minister of the Environment and received no later than 4:30 p.m. E.S.T. on April 20, 2011, at the following address:
