

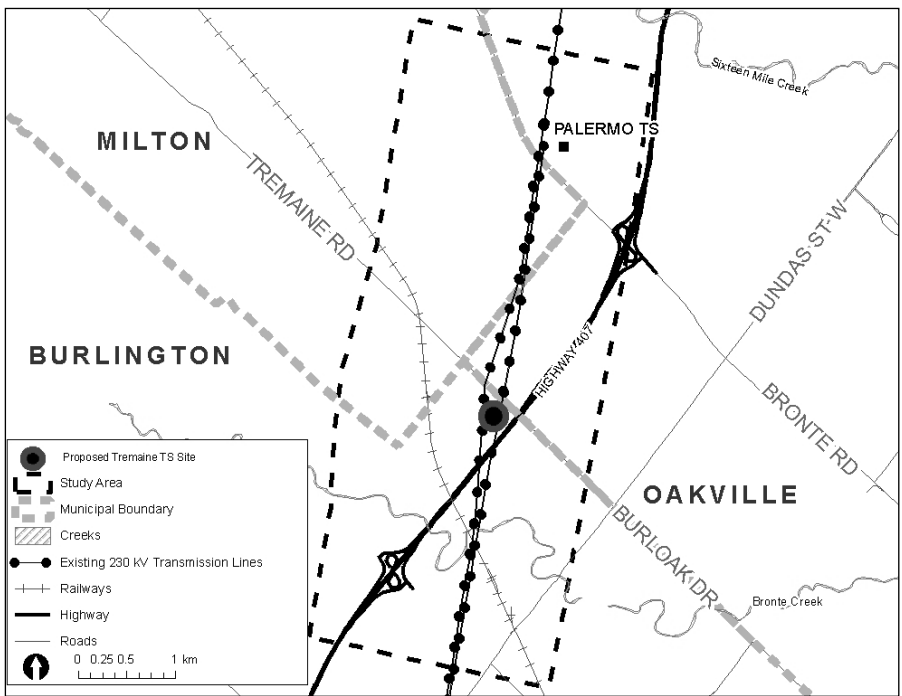
# You Are Invited to Public Information Centre #2

## Tremaine Transformer Station Class Environmental Assessment (EA)

Hydro One Networks Inc. (Hydro One) invites you to its second Public Information Centre (PIC) to review the proposed location for a new transformer station. The proposed Tremaine Transformer Station is required to ensure an adequate and reliable supply of power to meet growing electricity needs in the Regional Municipality of Halton, and would primarily serve Burlington Hydro and Milton Hydro customers.

### Preferred Site Identified

Since the initial PIC for this project held in April 2009, Hydro One has evaluated a number of alternative sites for the proposed transformer station. Hydro One's preferred site for the new station is located in the City of Burlington on the west side of Tremaine Road, just north of Hwy 407, as shown on the map below.



The proposed transformer station would consist of two transformers which would be connected to the existing double-circuit 230 kV transmission lines that run parallel to Highway 407 between Appleby Line and Regional Road 25.

This project is subject to the provincial *Environmental Assessment Act* in accordance with the *Class Environmental Assessment for Minor Transmission Facilities*.
