## **NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND HEARING**

### **HYDRO ONE NETWORKS INC. APPLICATION FOR LEAVE TO CONSTRUCT TRANSMISSION REINFORCEMENT FACILITIES IN THE CITY OF BRAMPTON**

Hydro One Networks Inc. (the “Applicant” or “Hydro One”) has filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board, (the “Board”) dated February 28, 2007 under section 92 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c.15, Schedule B. The Applicant has applied for an order of the Board for leave to construct approximately 3.0 kilometres of 230 Kilovolt underground transmission circuits. The proposed facilities will be installed in the City of Brampton at an estimated cost of approximately \$51 million.

The proposed facilities are to be located on an existing transmission line right of way between the Jim Yarrow Municipal Transformer Station (“Jim Yarrow MTS”) and the proposed Hurontario Switching Station. The facilities will not require the acquisition of any additional land or land rights. A map showing the location of the proposed facilities is included in this Notice.

The Board has assigned File No. EB-2007-0013 to this Application.

The Applicant is proposing to construct the facilities to improve the reliability and quality of electricity service to consumers in the Western Brampton area. This transmission reinforcement is intended to address electricity delivery and thermal overloading concerns on Hydro One’s existing supply circuits to Jim Yarrow MTS and Pleasant Transformer Station. In addition, this transmission reinforcement is intended to serve to increase the power transfer capability into the Toronto area from points west.

The Applicant proposes an in-service date for the new transmission facilities in June 2009.

### **How to see the Applicant's Pre-filed Evidence**

Copies of the Application and the pre-filed evidence in support of the Application will be available for public inspection at the Board's offices and at the Applicant's head office (addresses below).

### **How to Participate**

You may participate in this proceeding in one of three ways:

1. You may send the Board a letter of comment. Your letter should include any request to make an oral presentation to the Board, and must be received by the Board no later than **30 days** from the publication date of this Notice or, if you have been served this Notice personally, no later than **30 days** from the date of service.
2. You may request observer status in order to receive documents issued by the Board in the proceeding. Your request must be made by letter received by the Board no later than **10 days** from the publication date of this Notice or, if you have been served this Notice personally, no later than **10 days** from the date of service.
3. You may request intervenor status if you wish to actively participate in the proceeding. Your request must be made by letter of intervention received no later than **10 days** from the publication date of this Notice, or, if you have been served this Notice personally, no later than 10 days from the date of service. Your letter of intervention must include a description of how you are, or may be, affected by the proceeding and if you represent a group, a description of the group and its membership. The Board may choose to hold either a written or an oral hearing. Your letter of intervention should indicate your preference for a written or oral hearing, and the reasons for that preference. The Board may order costs in this proceeding. You must indicate in your letter of intervention whether you expect to seek costs from the Applicant and the grounds for your eligibility for costs. You must provide a copy of your letter of intervention to the Applicant.
