

- 1 4. Hydro One Networks seeks approval to refund regulatory assets with a net
2 balance of \$(26) million, to be refunded over a two-year period at \$(13) million
3 per year. The resulting distribution rate increase for the average customer,
4 relative to 2009 rates set by the Board under the 3rd Generation Incentive
5 Regulation Mechanism, will be approximately 9.7 % in 2010 and approximately
6 13.3% in 2011 on the distribution portion of the average customer bill. This
7 amounts to an average increase of approximately 3% on the average customer
8 total bill in of 2010 and approximately 4% in 2011.
9
- 10 5. Hydro One Networks requests approval for an updated smart meter funding adder
11 of \$2.17 in 2010 and \$4.45 in 2011 per month per metered customer to provide
12 funding for the 2010 and 2011 forecast smart meter in-service additions and
13 associated OM&A expenditures.
14
- 15 6. This Application also requests approval of new Retail Transmission Service Rates
16 to reflect the Board's approval of new Uniform Transmission Rates effective July
17 1, 2009 per their EB-2008-0272 Decision.

- 19 7. Hydro One Networks seeks approval for variance accounts related to impacts of
20 IFRS standard changes, fixed charges applied to micro-generators, variances in
21 actual pension costs, bill impact mitigation and incremental OEB costs.

- 23 8. Hydro One Networks seeks approval of the Company's Green Energy Plan filed
24 as part of this Application in accordance with the Deemed Conditions of Licence:
25 Distribution System Planning Guidelines G-2009-0087 issued June 16, 2009.

- 27 9. The evidence to be filed with the Board will include a full description of all costs
28 common to the Applicant's Distribution and Transmission activities, but the

1 revenue requirement and rates are based only upon those costs appropriately
2 allocated to the Distribution business.

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4 10. The written evidence filed with the Board may be amended from time to time
5 prior to the Board's final decision on the Application. Further, the Applicant may
6 seek meetings with Board staff and intervenors in an attempt to identify and reach
7 agreements to settle issues arising out of this Application.

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9 11. The persons affected by this Application are the ratepayers of Hydro One
10 Network's Distribution business. It is impractical to set out their names and
11 addresses because they are too numerous.
