



Good afternoon,

We're reaching out to provide an update on the construction of the Chatham to Lakeshore Line Project, a new double-circuit 230 kV transmission line we anticipate will be in-service by the end of 2025. The line will be approximately 49 km and extend between our Chatham Switching Station in Chatham-Kent to our Lakeshore Transmission Station in Lakeshore.
