

# Notice of Construction

## Hydro One is working in the Town of Mono to ensure a safe and continued supply of power

Starting this month, Hydro One crews will be replacing optical ground wire (OPGW) in the Town of Mono as the company replaces aging components of its transmission line between Orangeville and Barrie. OPGW is an important component on transmission lines that helps to energize life in Ontario by protecting equipment from lightning strikes and improving communication capabilities across the electricity system.

To complete this work, crews will be climbing structures to perform work, and will utilize ariel devices (bucket trucks) in conjunction with traffic control plans to install overhead protection equipment to safely cross roads. Crews will control vehicle and pedestrian traffic to ensure traffic flow is managed, however you may experience short delays when driving on the following municipal roads:
