

Notice of Temporary Road Closure

5 Line EHS – May 16th to June 30th

Hydro One is working in the Town of Mono to ensure a safe and continued supply of power

Hydro One crews will be replacing aging components on a transmission line that runs through the Town of Mono. To complete this work, 5 Line EHS between 25 Sideroad and Mono Centre Road (Dufferin Road 8) will be closed to local traffic only between May 16th to June 30th, 2022. On **May 30th & 31st** and **June 16th & 17th**, 5 Line EHS will be fully closed and only accessible to emergency vehicles. These dates are subject to change between May 16th and June 30th.

During this time crews will be working on replacing the sky wire, which is the upper most wire on the transmission line. This wire helps energize life in Ontario by protecting equipment from lightning strikes and improving communication capabilities across the electricity system.

To accommodate this work, Hydro One crews will be constructing a temporary stringing pad to gain access to tower structures and to allow for the safe operation of equipment. Periodically between May 16th and June 30th, you may notice crews climbing structures to perform work, and the use of aerial devices (bucket trucks) to install overhead protection equipment to safely cross roads. Residents will not experience a power outage as a result of this work.

We understand that construction can be disruptive, and thank you for your patience as we work to complete this important project.
