

## Construction Notice

**Islington Transformer Station and Line Project** 

June 2024

In the coming weeks work will begin to connect a new data facility to Hydro One's electricity grid in your community. Work will include building a new transformer station at 48 Lowe's Place and connecting the station to Hydro One's existing corridor south of Rexdale Blvd with two new underground 230 kilovolt transmission cables. The cables will be installed in a micro-tunnel under Highway 401 and in duct banks within street allowances from Pine Point Park to new junction stations within Hydro One's corridor, as shown on the map.

Hydro One has partnered with EHV Power and Somerville Construction to complete this important project and together we have developed a construction plan to minimize impacts to the community to the most extent possible. We recognize construction can be disruptive and we thank you for your patience as crews complete this work.

## What to expect

Roadwork	Temporary road closures along the project route will begin in July and be communicated to impacted residents in advance Road closure and detours will be marked with signage and traffic control where required Work areas will be restored following project completion
Pine Point Park	Crews will establish a work area within Pine Point Park. The work area will be fenced and the remaining park space and all park facilities will remain open Minor vegetation removals will be required Following completion of work the area will be restored in coordination with City of Toronto requirements
Timing	Work is expected to take place in residential areas Monday to Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Road closures will remain in effect outside of work hours Road work on Islington Ave and Rexdale Blvd will be coordinated with the City of Toronto and may take place after hours to minimize disruptions to traffic
