Islington Transformer Station and Line Project

February 2024

As industry and businesses grow in the City of Toronto, so does the need for safe, clean and reliable power. Hydro One is completing a project to connect a new data facility at 48 Lowe's Place in Etobicoke, to the electricity grid. The project includes:

- Building a new 230 kilovolt (kV) transformer station (TS) on the data facility's property.
- Installing two new junction stations (JCT), within the existing Hydro One corridor south of Rexdale Boulevard.
 JCTs help transition power from overhead transmission lines to underground cables.
- Installing two new underground 230 kV transmission cables between the new JCTs and TS.

Construction is planned to begin in the spring of 2024.

The community is invited to attend a Community Open House to learn about construction staging, temporary impacts to local streets and driveways as well as overall project information.
