West Toronto Transmission Line Relocation

Project Update and Invitation to Community Open House

May 2024

Hydro One is committed to energizing life for communities across Ontario, including supporting transit initiatives in the Greater Toronto Area. In 2022, Hydro One began the West Toronto Transmission Line Relocation project to support the Metrolinx planned electrification of the Barrie Rail Corridor.

The purpose of the project is to relocate existing overhead lines which interfere with planned Metrolinx infrastructure between St. Clair Avenue West and Bowie Avenue, just north of Eglinton Avenue West.

We heard your feedback

Initially, three open-cut route alternatives were identified within city streets to relocate this critical electrical infrastructure. Since project inception, we have been reviewing environmental and technical data, and collecting feedback on alternative routes and construction methods. Based on this analysis and information, a deep, underground tunnel route has now been identified as the preferred route.

The majority of the proposed tunnel would run underneath Caledonia Road at a depth of between 10 to 40 metres underground and would connect into new junction stations located at each end of the tunnel. A junction station facilitates the transition from overhead to underground lines. These sites would also serve as tunnel shafts for construction and access points for ongoing maintenance and operational needs.




