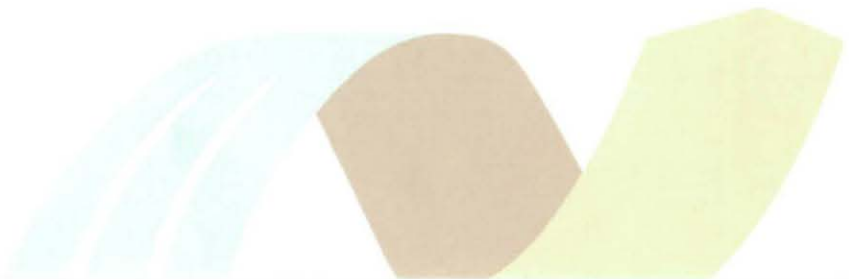
We will communicate a decision on the 2020 conference as soon as it's determined safe to do so. If you haven't already cancelled your hotel accommodations, please do so immediately.

In the past weeks, our country has come together to overcome the COVID-19 pandemic. Canadians have demonstrated resilience, and readiness in the face of these challenges. As you know, in the coming weeks and months, we will all be tasked with reviving our nation's economy and getting Canadians back to work. We hope that all levels of government, industry, and labour will come together as we embark on this path, together. This will not be an easy task. It will require all of our best efforts, collaboration, and an ambitious plan of action.

Through consultation with our partner employers, it is our belief that government collaboration is essential to getting Ontarians back to work and back to supporting their families and communities. LiUNA Local 183 members are proud of their work and are eager to return to their jobs. Our employer partners are equally eager to resume normal business operations.

We believe that we all have a role to play in rebuilding our economy, and that by working together – governments, employers, and labourers – we can do just that. While COVID-19 has presented us with a challenge not seen since the Second World War, it also presents us with an opportunity to make investments that will pay dividends for decades to come. Certainly, as in the years after the 2008 recession, "shovel-ready" projects will be the focus of stimulus spending.

This presents a chance to invest in the infrastructure that everyday Canadians use on an ongoing basis: roads, bridges, community and civic centres, utilities, sewers and watermains, dedicated cycling lanes and paths, and residential units – including government subsidized housing, to name a few.



*Feel the Power*

We know, however, that this pandemic is different from the 2008 recession, and that even in the best-case scenario, life will not return to normal for months. Considering this, the government cannot overlook projects which are in the final stages of planning and will be shovel-ready in the coming months. Further, investments in reliable public transit are not only central to the daily lives of Canadians but also essential to meeting our commitments to the fight against climate change. These public transit projects, some nearing their construction phase, will also guarantee that the government's investment is prudent, and reflects our shared vision for the country. As we rebuild, we have the opportunity to follow through on our existing commitments, while creating rewarding, lasting jobs for tens of thousands of workers across all sectors of the economy.

In consultation with our Employers Partner Associations, I am attaching submissions that we have received highlighting significant "shovel ready" and "shovel worthy" projects that will be vital to kickstarting our economy. These submissions also highlight practical policy recommendations that will ensure stimulus funds are efficiently allocated.

In addition, we would like to highlight several public transit projects that are critical to the health of the region. In the GTA, Premier Ford announced four priority transit projects which will greatly increase mobility around the region and unlock economic opportunities for under-served communities. These four projects begin with the Ontario Line which is set to see early construction works in 2021. With joint federal and provincial support, the Ontario Line could almost instantaneously create thousands of jobs for laid-off workers and put money into the hands of Ontario families in need.

We would also like to highlight the Hamilton LRT project, which was recently identified as a priority by the Hamilton Transit Taskforce struck by the Government of Ontario. While Hamilton is growing as an economic hub, public transit in the western GTHA has not kept pace with the needs of new industries, employers, and families. This project is an opportunity to build the connections that the Hamilton region needs to flourish, and to get workers and families to the places they need to go.

All of us are eager to work collaboratively with all levels of government and other stakeholders to rebuild our economy. We hope that you will consider some of the "shovel-ready" projects highlighted in the following appendices as well as prudent medium- to long-term investments in public transit.

We look forward to discussing a collaborative way to benefit Ontario families, businesses, and the Canadian economy.

### **Economic Recovery Priorities for Ontario: Infrastructure Construction**

Our three Associations perform the majority of the civil infrastructure work in the Greater Toronto Area – specifically building and maintaining the roads and bridges, sewer and watermain construction, work on subways and rapid transit systems. Collectively we employ over 10,000 workers in the GTA, representing wages and benefits of over \$750 million per year.

In planning to re-start the Ontario economy and establish the fundamentals for broader economic recovery the Ontario Government should focus first on and support a return to full operation in the civil construction; contractors that build and maintain public infrastructure and core infrastructure for private-sector development.

A full return to work in the other sectors of the construction industry – commercial, industrial, residential, etc. – are dependant on core infrastructure being in place. To facilitate opening up these construction sectors and ensuring that they have work immediately ready to return to when the Government eases restrictions, full restoration of the infrastructure construction sector is necessary as a first step to re-opening the entire construction industry.

The rationale for targeting infrastructure construction as a priority in re-opening the Ontario economy includes:

- The civil construction sector has been active throughout the COVID crisis performing work on municipal and provincial infrastructure work determined to be 'essential services' and retained its workforce and capabilities. Contractors are in a position to return to full operation immediately.
- Civil contractors have demonstrated their abilities throughout the COVID crisis to comply with COVID management best practices for health and safety, including social distancing on worksites.
- Opening up the infrastructure construction sector as one of the post-COVID recovery priorities involves putting thousands of skilled workers back into well-paying jobs, reducing the reliance of these workers on government relief programs and generating significant economic stimulus.
- Construction is a seasonal industry and the civil construction sector has already lost 15%-20% of the time available to get infrastructure in place this spring and summer. If this opportunity is missed due to extended COVID management restrictions, vital economic stimulus to fuel the Ontario recovery will be delayed until at least the spring

of 2021. If the infrastructure construction sector is re-opened now, stimulus benefits can begin to be realized this year.

Public infrastructure development is a recognized trigger for economic growth and development and a prerequisite to restarting the Ontario economy. Such investment supports not only good jobs for workers but also generates future dividends in terms of general economic growth.

Ontario municipalities have been delaying and cancelling infrastructure projects and maintenance work planned for this year, at least partially due to funding uncertainties. It is recommended that the Ontario Government direct Infrastructure Stimulus Funding to municipal infrastructure development as a proven means of generating economic stimulus and further that the provincial Government encourage the federal government to support this priority through its Infrastructure Stimulus Funding.

Municipal Asset Management Plans should be relied upon determine the prioritization of projects to be supported by stimulus funding. This would ensure that projects are staged in a manner that best meets the municipality's demands for efficient growth and would also reduce or eliminate the lag-time experienced in past programs that required the federal application and selection process.

Private development be it residential, industrial or commercial provides significant economic stimulus and growth in the Ontario economy. Private development has been stalled through the COVID crisis due to restrictions on the same infrastructure construction activities as have been permitted as essential service on municipal and provincial infrastructure development. In order to take full advantage of the economic benefits when the private sector returns to pre-COVID conditions, the infrastructure must be in place.

Specifically, it is important to immediately restart earthworks and related core infrastructure that must be in place before building construction can begin. This includes earthmoving, excavation, underground servicing, installation of sewer and water pipes, storm water controls and roads, including curbs and sidewalks. With COVID management measures in place, this is relatively lower risk as equipment operators work alone in their machines and spacing of workers onsite can be successfully achieved.

Planning for economic recovery and injection of stimulus funding also allow the Government to consider funding larger, more visionary infrastructure projects that provide good jobs and immediate economic stimulus and also position the Province and municipalities for future



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growth and economic development. Such investment can bring forward important and necessary projects that might not be feasible for years down the road.

Examples of this type of stimulus project include running large-scale water supply lines to areas of the GTA that are set for major residential and commercial development, major expansions of municipal road systems, or storm water mitigation projects similar to the ones in the City of Toronto's Wet Weather Flow Master Plan that could be built sooner than planned with stimulus funding.

Another potential 'legacy project' that might be considered as a driver of economic recovery is the Greater Toronto Area West Highway Corridor which the government has as a future plan for further down the road. This new highway would run between Milton and Vaughan, roughly parallel to and north of the existing Highway 407. Projections indicate if the highway is built it would carry 300,000 vehicles per day by 2031, significantly relieving congestion on the existing GTA highway network. Environmental assessment was scheduled to be completed this year and with some proactive planning could potentially be ready for shovels in the ground relatively quickly.



The Residential Construction Council of Ontario (RESCON) represents the interests of low, mid, and high-rise residential builders with a focus on GTA. With the Ontario Residential Council of Construction Associations (ORCCA), we represent hundreds of employers, ten of thousands of workers, and the interests of the entire unionized residential construction industry.

The GTA has been widely noted as having the most tower cranes operating in North America. The GTA is one of the most rapidly growing major metropolitan areas.

In short, construction is a powerhouse for the economy and of vital strategic importance. The Covid19 effect on the real estate and housing construction market is unpredictable, unfolding but already presenting considerable challenges on every level in terms of delays and upended schedules.

- Credit Availability - It is entirely possible it will have a serious impact in the short to medium term on credit availability for new projects.
- Rental and Affordable Housing - Assistance may be required especially with respect to rental and affordable housing and the potential use of government lands.
- Zoning and site plan barriers - This needs to be addressed at the local level to facilitate development.
- Portland's Redevelopment - The redevelopment of the Toronto Portland's should be accelerated. It could be a national symbol of sustainable resilient rebuilding.
- Approvals Process - Municipalities provide various project review, permitting and inspection services to the industry will require assistance to offset revenue reductions and have modernize their operations through web-based approvals and inspection systems. Modernizing the developing and building approvals process and cutting red tape will be crucial to recovery. Canada is currently ranked 64<sup>th</sup> in the World Bank survey on places to do business subcategory on construction permitting.
- Market Cooling Measures - Measures than were intended to cool the housing market such as the stress test and foreign buyers' tax should be lifted.
- Immigration - Measures with respect to immigration and the impact on recovery should be considered. Immigration should be sustained, and targets should be guided by the recovery.

There are numerous projects that could be ready in as early as 6 months. With some effort, the Hamilton LRT is one such example, which would generate thousands of work hours, economic growth and development for the city and province, whilst maintaining the federal government objective of constructing carbon neutral infrastructure projects. Beyond rail, there are several developments that will be constructed along the suggested LRT route that will have a significant economic impact not only in the City of Hamilton, but for several neighbouring cities, the province, and the country. The Hamilton LRT is one of many infrastructure investments that will serve as a catalyst for stimulating economic development and generate much needed revenue for the city and ultimately for the province.

Through our collaborative efforts with the government and consultation with employer partners, it is our belief that by investing in critical infrastructure build, will be vital to kickstart the economy, get Canadians back to work and build stronger, prosperous communities across our country.

Dear Mac Potter,

Thank you for your interest in the Hydro One Waasigan Transmission Line project and your questions and comments on the draft Terms of Reference (ToR). Waasigan will increase the amount of electricity flowing through the system and provide local businesses and communities the power they need to grow, including the mining and forestry sectors. Hydro One is completing the development work now to ensure we are ready to support the economic growth in the northwest.

The following provides responses to your questions and comments received on July 30, 2020, including the addition of numerical references.

***Question 1: Can Hydro One please confirm that plans include the installation of a new series of towers supporting a single circuit 230 kV line, as described in the draft ToR?***

Yes, the project will involve the installation of new support towers for the transmission line.

***Question 2: What is the anticipated ROW required for the installation of these towers as it sits adjacent to a previously created ROW?***

The width of the right-of-way (ROW) will vary depending on the location and/or section of the transmission line. For the purposes of the draft ToR, we have assumed a width of approximately 45-metres. This will vary at certain locations, including sharp turns and major water crossings. The final ROW width requirements will be confirmed during the design phase of the project.

**Question 3: When does Hydro One anticipate identifying the preferred route south or north of the current infrastructure? ROW needs directly impact infrastructure plans related to water management at the Goliath Gold Project to the north of the current line, and processing plant and waste rock storage to the south.**

The preferred route for the transmission line will be determined in the future environmental assessment (EA) phase of the project. Subject to Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) approval of the ToR, the EA is expected to commence in early 2021. Hydro One will engage with interested stakeholders, including Treasury Metals Inc., as part of the process to select the preferred route.

**Question 4: As indicated in the Record of Consultation, Treasury Metals provided shapefiles to the Hydro One team on May 28, 2019. Can you confirm who sent the shapefiles, and what was provided? Treasury Metals would like to ensure Hydro One has the correct information, and the considerations put forth in the finalization of the federal Environmental Assessment approved in August 2019 is considered.**

Hydro One received shapefiles from Treasury Metals on May 28, 2019. The email was sent by Robyn Gaebel, P.Eng., Environmental Superintendent of Treasury Metals Inc. Several shapefiles were provided in three folders: 2017 Proposed Site Layout, Mineralized Zones at Surface, and Property Boundary. If you required additional information, please let us know.
