LEASIDE TO MAIN

INFRASTRUCTURE REFURBISHMENT PROJECT



Dear Neighbour April 2018

Hydro One is making important upgrades to critical transmission equipment in your community which was installed in the 1960s. These upgrades are essential to ensure a strong, reliable supply of power to Toronto Hydro customers.

Work includes replacing an underground hydro cable that runs under the southbound lane of Main St. (between Stephenson Ave. and Lumsden Ave.) and under the eastbound lane of Lumsden Ave. (between Main St. and Eastdale Ave.). In order to replace the cable, crews will be excavating parts of the roadways and sidewalks.

The next section of construction will begin concurrently north of the Main Street TTC station to Doncaster Ave. and on Lumsden Ave. between Main St. and Barrington Ave.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION: UPDATE 2

WEEKDAY HOURS	Work will take place Monday-Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. (Work may extend past these hours in special circumstances and occasional work on Saturdays may be required).
UTILITY DISRUPTIONS	There are no planned disruptions to your power or other utilities during construction.
TIME OUTSIDE YOUR HOME	Construction will be completed in rolling work zones. Within each section, excavation work will occur in front of five to ten homes at one time (diagram shown on reverse). We expect to be in front of each home for less than two weeks. You will receive a second notice directly from Hydro One's Construction Ambassador prior to work beginning outside your home.
000	Main St. will be restricted to motorists in areas where excavation is occurring. The remainder of the work zone will be open to local residents, emergency services, garbage/snow removal, utilities and construction vehicles. Traffic detours via Chisholm Ave. and Doncaster Ave. will be in effect while work is completed on Main St.
TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT	Lumsden Ave. will be reduced to one lane, however two-way traffic will be maintained by a flag person. Signage will be in place to inform community members of road restrictions.
	Main St. Residents: While excavation occurs outside your home, your driveway access will be temporarily restricted; however, parking will be reserved within work zones. We are pleased to arrange temporary permit parking during this time. See instructions on the reverse.
PARKING AND DRIVEWAY ACCESS	Lumsden Ave. Residents: While excavation occurs outside your home, driveway access will be restricted during working hours and restored at night (using steel plates).
SIDEWALKS	 All Main St. sidewalks will remain open. The south sidewalk on Lumsden Ave. will be restricted during working hours.
TTC: 87 COSBURN, 62 MORTIMER	 To accommodate construction, two TTC bus routes (87 Cosburn and 62 Mortimer) will be temporarily rerouted. 87 Cosburn: diverted southbound via Barrington Ave. and northbound via Chisholm Ave. 62 Mortimer: diverted in both directions via Chisholm Ave. For more information, visit projects.ttc.ca.
NOISE	You can expect an increase in noise, heavy machinery and activity during construction, however, all work will comply with City of Toronto's by-laws.


