### WORK IS STARTING IN YOUR COMMUNITY

#### Dear Neighbour

In mid-March, Hydro One will begin making important upgrades to critical transmission equipment in your community which was installed in the 1960s. These upgrades are essential to ensure a strong, reliable supply of power to Toronto Hydro customers.

Work will include replacing an underground hydro cable that runs under Main St. (between Stephenson Ave. and Lumsden Ave.) and under Lumsden Ave. (between Main St. and Eastdale Ave.). In order to replace the cable, crews will be excavating parts of the roadways and sidewalks in rolling sections. We anticipate work will be completed by August 2018.

**Please note construction disruptions will vary as work progresses. We will be sending out additional notices as well as dropping by your home as construction progresses outlining these details.**

Construction will begin at Danforth Ave. and Main Street TTC Station, moving north. The below details describe what community members can expect during this first section.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION - UPDATE 1

 <p><b>WEEKDAY HOURS</b></p>	<p>Work will take place Monday-Friday, 7:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. (work may extend past these hours in special circumstances)</p>
 <p><b>UTILITY DISRUPTIONS</b></p>	<p>There are no planned disruptions to your power or other utilities during construction.</p>
 <p><b>TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT</b></p>	<p>The southbound lane of Main Street, between Danforth Ave. and Main Street TTC station will be restricted; however two-way traffic flow will be maintained. Construction signage will be in place to advise motorists of road restrictions. As we move north, the road will be open to local traffic only and there will be no through traffic permitted in areas where excavation is occurring. More details on this will be provided in the next update.</p>
 <p><b>SIDEWALKS</b></p>	<p>Access to approximately half of the west sidewalk, closest to the road, will be restricted. The remainder of the sidewalk will remain open for pedestrian traffic. For public safety, fencing will be enclosed around our work area.</p>
 <p><b>NOISE</b></p>	<p>You can expect an increase in noise, heavy machinery and activity during construction; however, all work will comply with City of Toronto's by-laws.</p>


