We are writing to provide you with an update on Hydro One's Leaside to Main project. As you may be aware, Hydro One is continuing work to install a new underground cable between our Main Transformer Station (TS) and Lumsden Junction (Jct) to ensure a reliable supply of electricity to local customers.

Since our work began in March, we have focused our efforts on installing a cable duct which will house the new cable. We are happy to announce that trenching activities are expected to be completed by mid-November.

As a next step we will be constructing two connection points, known as joint bays, which will allow us to join two sections of cable from both of our facilities noted above. **These joint bays will be constructed in approximately the middle of the road along Main St. between Doncaster Ave. and Lumsden Ave.** The construction of these joint bays will take approximately 2 months. Following that, we will complete remaining critical activities including cable pulling, jointing and cable testing which will take approximately 3 months. Construction of the joint bays will begin on October 29th, 2018. Due to the significant excavation required to install the joint bays, all construction activities are scheduled to be completed by mid-April 2019.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION: UPDATE 4

 Weekday Hours	<p>Work will take place Monday-Friday, 7:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. (work may extend past these hours in special circumstances)</p>
 Traffic Management	<p>Throughout the joint bay construction, through traffic on Main St. between Doncaster Ave. and Lumsden Ave. (adjacent to the joint bay area) will be closed during working hours (7 a.m. – 5 p.m.). After 5 p.m., one lane of traffic in this area will be open to allow through traffic.</p>
 Holiday Season	<p>Construction activities will be put on-hold during the holiday season from December 22nd to January 6th. During this time, there will be no restrictions to any driveways or street traffic.</p>
 Noise	<p>You can expect an increase in noise, heavy machinery and activity during construction; however, all work will comply with City of Toronto's by-laws.</p>
