

### **Our commitment**

Hydro One has committed to increasing Indigenous procurement spend to **5%** of the company's purchases of materials and services by **2026**. We will build long-standing, mutually beneficial relationships with Indigenous businesses to achieve this target.

For most major projects, Hydro One requires suppliers to procure from Indigenous businesses, further increasing Indigenous spend across our entire supply chain.

### Our definition of an Indigenous business

Hydro One considers an Indigenous business as having at least 51% ownership (including Joint Ventures by an Indigenous company, community or person(s).

Hydro One has the discretion to assess and procure from other businesses with a substantial amount of ownership rights held by one or more Indigenous businesses or people.
