

ONTARIO ELECTRICITY REBATE DECLARATION FORM INSTRUCTIONS

The Ontario Electricity Rebate ("OER") provides eligible customers with a 17% reduction on the amount of their bill before HST, effective November 1, 2021. If you have a multi-unit complex that uses more than 250,000 kWh a year, it may be eligible to receive the OER. To see if your multi-unit complex is eligible, please complete a declaration form.

Scenario A:

Multi-unit complexes billed by one meter

- Please complete this form if your multi-unit complex is not currently receiving the OER and you believe you may be eligible for it.
- Eligibility will be determined based on the information provided in the declaration form.

Scenario B:

Licensed long-term care homes

- If you have a long-term care home that is licensed under the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007
 (other than an account that is also in respect of a hospital as defined in the Broader Public
 Sector Accountability Act, 2010) you are eligible to receive the OER.
- Please complete and submit the enclosed declaration form.

DEFINITIONS

A "unit" is defined as:

- a. A unit as defined in the Condominium Act, 1998,
- b. A residential unit or a rental unit, as those terms are defined in subsection 2 (1) of the Residential Tenancies Act, 2006,
- c. A member unit or a non-member unit, as those terms are defined in the *Co-operative Corporations Act*, or
- d. Premises for the purposes of the Commercial Tenancies Act.

Ineligible premises are defined as (referred to in Question 5c):

- A hotel, motel, motor hotel, resort, lodge, tourist camp, cottage or cabin establishment, inn, campground, trailer park, tourist home, bed and breakfast vacation establishment or vacation home
- Living accommodation occupied by a person for penal or correctional purposes
- A hospital
- A premises that is subject to the Ministry of Correctional Services Act or the Child, Youth and Family Services Act, 2017
- Short-term living accommodation provided as emergency shelter
- Living accommodation provided by an educational institution to its students or staff where:
 - o The living accommodation is provided primarily to the persons under the age of majority, or all major questions related to the living accommodation are decided after consultation with a council or association representing the residents, and
 - o The living accommodation is not intended for year-round occupancy by full-time students or staff and members of their households.
- A university, college of applied arts and technology or other entity that provides post-secondary education
- Premises in the mining, quarrying, oil and gas extraction, utilities, construction and manufacturing sectors (i.e., identified by a NAICS code commencing with the digits 21, 22, 23, 31, 32 or 33)
