## **Regulated Price Plan**

## Self-declaration form instructions

Under Ontario regulations, a consumer with an account that falls into one of a prescribed set of classes as described below is to be billed under the **Regulated Price Plan (RPP)**.

Hydro One automatically enrolls some accounts in the RPP due to the consumer's consumption and demand profiles as described in Step 1, sections 1 through 3. However, some accounts, as described in Step 1, sections 4 and 5, are not automatically enrolled and must self-declare account eligibility with Hydro One in order to be enrolled in the RPP.

Effective November 1, 2020, in accordance with section 3.5 of the Ontario Energy Board's Standard Supply Service Code, consumers have the option of being charged RPP Time-of-Use (TOU) rates or tiered pricing. Consumers that have an interval meter also have the option of being charged the Wholesale Electricity Price. Consumers may also elect to sign a contract with an electricity retailer for commodity supply. For more information please visit our Hydro One site **here**.

At any time after the self-declaration, the consumer can choose to switch between RPP TOU, RPP tiered or the Wholesale Electricity Price pricing. Requests to change your price plan can be emailed to <u>CICR@HydroOne.com</u> and should include your account number and your service address.

If the request is submitted by a third party, please include a letter of authorization permitting the third party to act on your behalf. If you change your price plan, the change will be effective as of the next bill period.

If you're interested in self-declaring and having your account enrolled in the RPP, please complete the steps below.

## Step 1: Eligibility for the Regulated Price Plan

Ontario Regulation 95/05 under the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998 stipulates the eligibility for the Regulated Price Plan as follows:

- 1. Low-volume consumers (consumers who annually use less than 150,000 kilowatt hours of electricity).
- 2. A consumer has a demand of 50 kilowatts or less.
- 3. A consumer who annually uses at least 150,000 but not more than 250,000 kilowatt hours of electricity.
- 4. A consumer who has an account with a distributor, if the account relates to,
  - I. a dwelling,
  - II. a property as defined in the <u>Condominium Act, 1998</u>,
  - III. a residential complex as defined in the <u>Residential Tenancies Act, 2006</u>, or
  - IV. a property that includes one or more dwellings and that is owned or leased by a co-operative as defined in the <u>Co-operative Corporations Act</u>.
- 5. A consumer who has an account with a distributor if the consumer,
  - I. carries on a business that is a farming business for the purposes of the <u>Farm Registration and Farm Organizations Funding Act, 1993</u>, and
  - II. holds a valid registration number assigned under that Act or the consumer's obligation to file a farming business registration form was waived pursuant to an order made under subsection 22 (6) of that Act.
